School-based After-school Learning and Support Programme 2006 ~ 2007 Report:

(I) Aim : The aim of this scheme is to help students to overcome difficulties in different areas, like communications with their peer groups, teachers and parents. Moreover, it is expected to help students to have all-round development in personal growth. Furthermore, it is expected to arouse students' interest in learning and their low learning motivation.

- (II) Target Group: Those students who come from low-income families.
- (III) Content: In order to fulfill the purpose of the scheme, the following items were done:
 - (i) After-school academic learning programme (Mathematics and Chinese) were given to S. 1 ~ S.3 students. During the first term, Mathematics (tutorial) was given to all Form 1 to Form 3 classes (i.e. 3 different classes). For each class, a tutor was employed to give tutorial to students. However, during the second term, Mathematics (tutorial) was given only to Form 2 and 3. On the other hand, Chinese (tutorial) was given to Form 2 and Form 3.
 - (ii) An activity was given to Form 3 students after the final examination in July. It included group games, led by social workers.
- (IV) Assessment:
 - (a) Most of the students were present in the tutorial, held once a week after school. From teachers' comment, those students taking the tutorial did better than before.
 - (b) From social workers' observation, most of the students were happy with the games related to team spirit and confidence.
- (V) Expenditure:
