With the School-Based Support Scheme Grant, the school was able to offer support to our newly arrived students in starting a new life in school and in Hong Kong. This year, we continued to work with Hong Kong Christian Service to serve the newly arrived students. Our comprehensive programme offered pastoral care to them and enhanced their personal growth through different indoor and outdoor activities that were both fun and educational.

Students were encouraged in each and every way to excel in their studies. To facilitate students' self-access learning, we offered them free check out of the iPod Touch from the NAC Resource Bank of the school. Supplementary exercise books and other learning materials were also provided. To ensure better catering for their needs, additional tutors were recruited to conduct small group tutoring for them throughout the year to support their learning in both English and Cantonese. Besides, certificates and tokens of recognition of effort were offered to them to inspire a higher expectation of themselves.

To help our newly arrived students to achieve a holistic personal development, the school provided various opportunities for students to strengthen their social skills, to stretch their leadership potential, and to enhance their self-esteem through activities such as the Buddy Programme and the Student Ambassador Programme.
